PRINCIPAL REPORT: Terry Humphreys

- Technology Upgrade proposal;

Replace 4 classroom white boards with large screen TV's w/most up to date technology.

Each TV w/wiring, supplies, & installation - approximate cost \$6400.00

Funds to cover cost;

2021 School year carryover	\$11,780
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Funds from staff asst. (unable to hire)	13,570
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Total current funds available	\$25,350
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Motion to approve - using the Carryover Funds and remaining funds in Land Trust budget presented and approved by members present (2). Email will be sent to remaining members (2) to review proposal and vote upon, vote will be written response through email.

Side Note – Our goal is to have all classrooms (starting with core subjects) with the most up to date TV/technology and hope this can happen with additional funding sources along with district funding that may be available.

- Funds for 2022-23 school year Staffing proposal;

Land Trust Funds to cover 1.25 teacher salaries – this would equal approximately \$75,000.

The Land Trust figures have not been disclosed for the 2022-23 school year as yet, however,

If the amount is similar to the 2021-22, this would be about 60% of Highland's allocation.

Actual allotment along with final proposals and school goals for the 2022-23 school year will be presented and proposed for final vote at the March 16, 2022 Community Council meeting.

- Process of finishing the last few 8th and 9th grade CCR meetings with students.
- The 7th grade CCR meetings will be held in their CCA class – parents will be invited to attend. Counselors are happy to report parent participation has increased this year with CCR parent/student meetings.
